## MEDITATE ON THIS ( [He is Alive](#) )



The resurrection of Jesus Christ was a pivotal event that changed everything. When the disciples came to the tomb to see His body, the angels asked them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?" This reminded them of Jesus' testimony about His resurrection. Later, the angels made it clear and declared, "He is not here; He is Risen!"

If the Roman empire had produced the body of Jesus after the crucifixion, it would have crushed the hope of the disciples that He was alive. But seeing the empty tomb and later seeing the resurrected Christ proved to them that Jesus had power over death, and that through faith in Him, they too could conquer and receive victory over death.

Unfortunately, many people in our world continue to seek for salvation in dead religions. However, Jesus is the only leader of any major world religion who is still alive, both sitting at the right hand of God the Father in Heaven, and alive in the presence of the Holy Spirit in every believer who has accepted Him as their Lord and Savior. The resurrection of Jesus changed everything, and it stands as the ultimate symbol of hope and victory over death. Happy Easter/Resurrection Sunday.
