WORD OF THE DAY ([Colossians 2:9-10](#))

“For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.”

MEDITATE ON THIS (**Jesus is Enough**)



Colossians 2:9-10 says, "For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority."

What a powerful and encouraging passage of scripture! Paul is reminding the Colossians, and us as believers today, that in Christ we have everything we need. The fullness of deity dwells bodily in Christ, and because we are in Him, we have been filled with His Spirit and given access to all the promises of God.

It can be so easy to get caught up in our circumstances and struggles and lose sight of the fact that we have been made complete in Christ. We can become discouraged and overwhelmed, feeling as though we are not enough or that we are lacking in some way. But the truth of Colossians 2:9-10 is that in Christ, we lack nothing. He is the head of all rule and authority, and through Him, we have access to the power and authority that comes with being children of God.

So, if you're feeling discouraged or overwhelmed, remember this passage. Remember that in Christ, you have been filled with the fullness of deity and made complete in Him. You lack nothing, and because of Christ, you are more than enough. So don't give up or lose heart, but hold fast to the truth of Colossians 2:9-10 and let it be a source of encouragement and strength in your life.
