### The Living WORD in YOU



**Jesus the Living WORD.** In John's Gospel, he reveals that the WORD of God has come to be with us as the Person of Jesus. The WORD was with God and the WORD was God in the beginning. As the WORD of God, he created all things and was with God and is God, and he has come to be with us. As the WORD of God, Jesus embodied the wisdom of God, taught the teachings of God, and demonstrated true worship and praise while on earth.

#### **The WORD returns victorious.**

We are told by God that the WORD will never return void and will accomplish all that is intended by God to accomplish. As the WORD of God, Jesus completed all that was needed. In addition to showing humanity God's overwhelming love for us, Jesus also provided a pathway to God, through faith in Him. Finally, Jesus defeated death and sin at the cross.

We must read God's Word eagerly (be joyful), purposefully (make it a priority), and systematically (study in order) in order to allow the living Word within us to triumph.
