MEDITATE ON THIS (Loyalty to the Lord)



In John 12:13, we read about the time when people spread palm branches and shouted "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!" These people were giving their all to praise Jesus, but fast forward just a few days later and we find that many of these same people were now shouting, "Crucify him!" It's easy to wonder how this could happen - how could people be so fickle in their loyalty to Christ?

The truth is that many of us are probably guilty of the same kind of disloyalty towards the Lord. We may praise Him and give Him our worship when things are going well, but as soon as our situations change, or our prayers go unanswered, we can quickly turn our backs on Him. We may even, at times, deny Him or walk away from Him completely.

However, even when our loyalty fails, God remains faithful. We may turn on Him, but He never

turns on us. We may forget about Him, but He never forgets about us. We may deny Him, but He never denies us.

Let's strive to remain loyal to the Lord, even in the midst of difficult circumstances or unanswered prayers. Let's remember that God is always on our side, and He will never leave us or forsake us. Let's praise Him not only with words, but with our actions and our lives, and let's trust in His goodness and faithfulness, even when we don't understand what He's doing.

May we all strive to be truly loyal to the Lord, and may He help us to remain faithful even when we face trials and difficulties along the way. Amen.
