




WORD OF THE DAY (Philippians 1:29)

MEDITATE ON THIS (The Privilege of Suffering)



As believers, we often focus on the privileges that come with being a follower of Christ such as eternal life, forgiveness of sins, and the blessings of the Holy Spirit. However, we often shy away from one of the most important privileges that is granted to us, which is the privilege of suffering for Jesus as a display of our love for Him.
